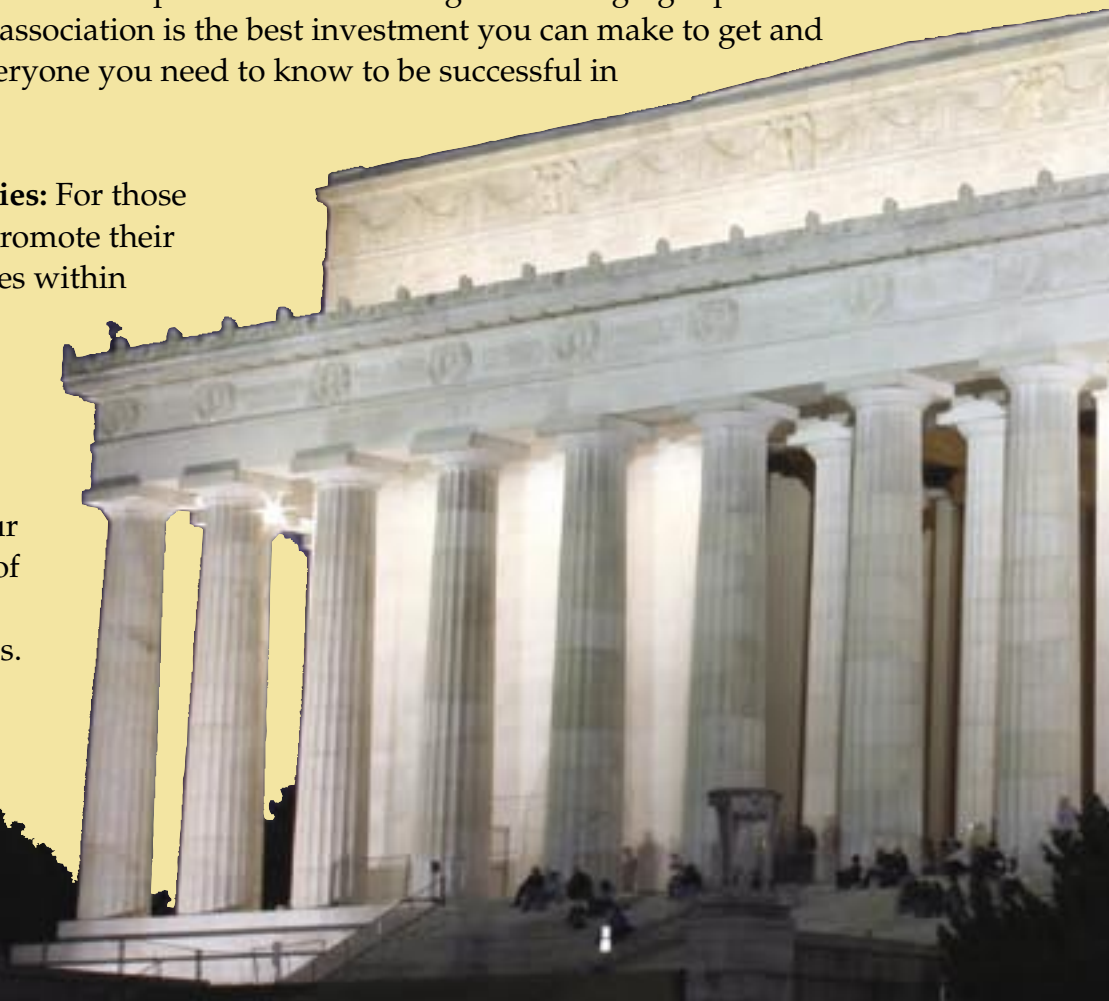

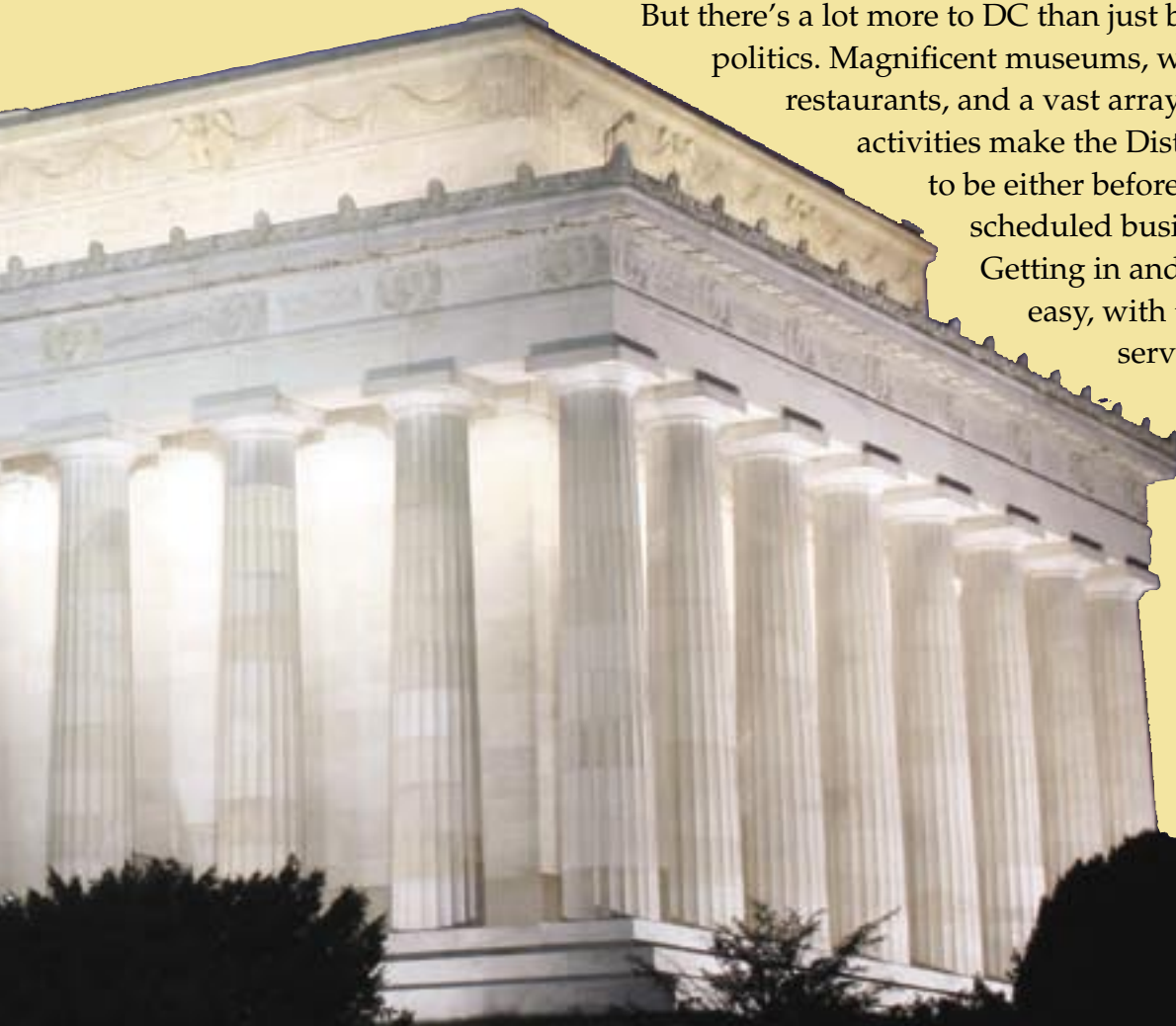


# A Great Place to Do Business
